Capital Credits = Ownership Share

Did you know being a customer of the Cooperative makes you a Member-Owner of the Cooperative? This means that every bill you pay is an investment into a system you own. As a nonprofit organization, any and all margins made in a year are returned to you, our members! Investor-owned utilities return profits to shareholders that you will never meet. We return them to you!



HOW CAPITAL CREDITS WORK





The cooperative keeps track of how much you pay for electricity from the cooperative all year.

The cooperative allocates positive margins to each member as capital credits based upon the amount each member paid for electricity that year. The allocation is added to your capital credit account and it is always yours, even if you move.






The cooperative calculates if the revenue collected for the year is more than the costs of operation. If there is more revenue than expenses, it's called a positive margin.





Capital credits in your account stay there to "go to work" funding operations until they retire. The credits can never be used or accessed in any other way until retirement.*







When capital credits retire, they transform into money that is distributed to you as a check or a credit on your bill.**

**The Board of Trustees consider the financial condition of the cooperative each year to determine if any capital credits can be retired.
